Who?

Residents and visitors of the Pacific Northwest

What?

A magnitude 9.0 earthquake similar to the 2011 quake in Japan. That could be 4 minutes of shaking!

Where?

The Cascadia Subduction Zone that runs from Northern California to Vancouver, about 100 miles off the coast.

When?

Hard to say. There is a 100% chance that it will happen. Scientists are estimating a 10% chance in the next 40 years.

So what should I do?

The Oregon Seismic Safety Policy Advisory Commission recommends community-level planning.








Who Will Save Me?
